

Cookies

To enable us to provide a helpful, reliable and user friendly service online, it is sometimes necessary to place small amounts of information on your computer or other device – these files are commonly referred to as cookies.

Our website is powered by Wordpress, which may use cookies that enable us to monitor and improve our services to you. The information gathered by cookies is anonymous and cannot be used to identify you personally or access any other personal information on your computer or device.

Cookies we use

- ***Cookietest***: to see if cookies are enabled in your browser.
- ***akm_mobile***: to see if you are viewing our website on your mobile.
- ***Botdlang***: to see which language you are using.
- ***tk_ni/tk_ai/tk_qs***: collects data on how you use our website.
- ***Ads***: to see if you have clicked on an advert before.
- ***wordpress_eli***: to reduce the display of adverts when you use our website more often.
- ***ab***: for a/b testing, where Wordpress compares two versions of a webpage to see which is best.

Most cookies will only be used if you comment on posts or create / log in to a Wordpress account. These include:

- ***nux_flow_name***: if create a Wordpress account, to see if you used a Wordpress form or a custom one.
- ***signup_partner_ref*** and ***signup_referrer***: tracks the source of new Wordpress accounts.

- ***wordpress_logged_in****: to see if you have logged in to Wordpress.
- ***twostep_auth***: if you log in to Wordpress using two step authentication.
- ***wp_sharing_{id}***: to see if you have already performed an action e.g. liking or sharing a post.
